



2019 HOLLE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN SCREENWRITING

DEADLINE: Friday, February 1, 2019 at 5:00pm

Description:

Students must submit a full-length feature script (80-120 pages) and include a one sentence logline. The script must be in proper format, three-hole punched and bound by two brads only – top and bottom left margins.

Authors may submit multiple entries, but each entry must meet the guidelines and criteria, and be accompanied by a separate submission form. All work must be complete. No partial scripts accepted.

Who's eligible? Undergraduate or graduate students enrolled during the 2018-2019 academic year or who have graduated the year before from such a program (Students who graduate in May 2018, August 2018, December 2018, or May 2019 are eligible.)

Students must attend one of the following schools: University of Alabama, University of Alabama Birmingham, Birmingham Southern, Lawson State College, University of North Alabama, Auburn University, University of South Alabama, Stillman College, Samford University, and Emory University. All academic majors qualify.

Main Guidelines:

Students must submit a full-length feature script (80-120 pages) and include a cover page with a one sentence logline and the contact info of the author. Only .pdf files will be accepted.

Authors may submit multiple entries, but each entry must meet the guidelines and criteria, and be accompanied by a separate submission form.

Author must be an undergraduate or graduate student during the 2018-2019 academic year at one of the following schools: University of Alabama, University of Alabama Birmingham, Birmingham Southern, Lawson State College, University

of North Alabama, Auburn University, University of South Alabama, Stillman College, Samford University, and Emory University. All academic majors qualify.

All work must be complete. No partial scripts accepted.

Additional Guidelines:

Author must be an undergraduate or graduate student during the 2017-2018 academic year at one of the following schools: University of Alabama, University of Alabama Birmingham, Birmingham Southern, Lawson State College, University of North Alabama, Auburn University, University of South Alabama, Stillman College, Samford University, and Emory University. All academic majors qualify.

Script must be a full-length feature, no less than 80 pages and no more than 120 pages. Scripts shorter or longer than this range will not be considered.

The script must follow industry standard script formatting. Any variation could result in disqualification.

You must have a title page, which includes a one-sentence logline and your contact info.

Entries may be disqualified if they contain egregious and/or consistent spelling or grammatical mistakes.

All work must be complete. No partial scripts accepted.

The entry must be an original work. No adaptations of other artistic works of any kind.

No more than two authors on one entry. If a writing team wins the award, the cash prize will be evenly split. No exceptions. Authors must attend the same school.

Authors may submit multiple entries, but each entry must meet the guidelines and criteria, and be accompanied by a separate submission form. Late entries will not be accepted.

Deadline for submissions is February 1st, by 5:00 p.m.
