Lead a five-day, four-night media experience for high school students!  
You must be available from July 14-18, 2020.

### About CAMP

C&IS CAMP - Communication and Media Preview - offers high school students (rising sophomores through seniors) the opportunity to interact with UA faculty, staff, alumni and current students while learning about communication and media industries over a five-day, four-night experience at UA. CAMP participants will explore communication and media topics such as broadcast news, media production and social media while learning how to tell stories in a hands-on environment.

### Leadership Team Overview

The CAMP leadership team is a group of upperclassmen student leaders who are passionate about C&IS and its resources and eager to share their experiences with high school students interested in communication and media. During CAMP, the leadership team will facilitate discussion and completion of a multifaceted campaign project spearheaded by the participants. Team members will work alongside C&IS faculty in teaching, mentoring, and preparing students to develop and present their final campaign project. They will also facilitate the CAMP schedule by guiding students through the sessions, facilities, and social activity times. Members of the leadership team should have a strong understanding of The College of Communication and Information Sciences and The University of Alabama. They should exhibit a willingness to serve as a resource regarding campus information, CAMP content and the CAMP participant experience. To prepare for the experience, leaders will spend time in the spring semester attending training workshops. All C&IS majors are eligible to apply.

### Minimum Requirements:

- 2.75 GPA
- Good academic standing and conduct standing with the University
- Uphold all expectations on the contract (will be distributed at training)
- Attend training sessions
- Be in active communication with Tisch Student Services and External Relations (regularly check and respond to any communication about CAMP)
